Wood Oil Palette (Or Palette Paper)

Palette Knife

Strathmore Oil Painting Paper (12 x 12 inches)

Gamsol (For Cleaning Purposes)

Acrylic Paint (For Underpainting)

*Note: It's important to think about the storage for your oil paintings before starting to use oil paint. You might need a drying rack for paper pieces. Consider using a wall to hang your wet pieces or an out of the way shelf.*

These are my favorite oil paint colors that I almost always use to fill my palette. I would recommend mixing your own colors in the beginning or just starting with a few of your favorite colors.
