Materials & Supplies List:

Gelli Arts® printing plate 3"x5"

<u>Gel printing plate 6"x6"</u>

<u>Soft rubber brayer 2"</u>

Papers: Tissue paper, Copy paper
Paper (220 gsm - 20"x6")
Cardboard (3x slightly larger than 4"x6")
Smooth cotton

Acrylic paint (<u>Liquitex Basics Brilliant Blue</u>, Dina Wakley Media: <u>Elephant</u>, <u>Heather</u>, <u>Magenta</u>, <u>Mineral</u>, Ara Old Delft Prussian Blue, <u>Titanium White</u>, <u>Winsor&Newton Payne's Gray</u>)

Fabric medium

Matte medium or gel medium (Liquitex)

Iron-on double-sided adhesive for fabric + iron + baking paper

Double-Sided Adhesive (Grafix Artist-tac)

Masking tape

Glue stick

Damp cloth or baby wipe

Something heavy (weights, books)

Scissors

Texture makers (Beads glued to chipboard, corrugated cardboard, 3D liner on cardstock, eyelash yarn, Gelli Arts® Mini Printing Tool, machine-stitched cardstock)

Hand-cut masks and stencils

Textured textiles (Fabric, lace trim, aida, netting fabric, tulle, crochet doily, gauze, upholstery fabric, jute etc.

Optional:

Freezer paper
Acrylic stamping block
Alphabet stickers
Heat tool
Fabric tape
Sewing machine
