The Layers Begin Here: Your Supply List

*The highlighted supply items are what we will be using in the Soulful Stories Starter Lessons

Before we begin, let's take a gentle pause...

Gathering your supplies is more than checking off a list—it's the first step in connecting with the stories waiting to unfold within you. Each material, no matter how small or humble, will play its part in this layered journey of creativity and healing.

This isn't about having everything or the "perfect" tools. It's about showing up for yourself with what feels right, trusting that the magic comes through in the process. I'll guide you through what you'll need—layers of paper, paint, textures, and an inspirational bundle of personal materials.

For an in-depth journey into the many materials you might gather for this project, I invite you to download the <u>Creative Guide to Healing and Art</u>. It's brimming with inspiration and ideas to spark your imagination and help you discover the treasures waiting to be part of your story.

Take a deep breath, make a warm cup of tea, and let's get started...

The Substrate

You'll need a sturdy surface that can hold up to the layers of this mixed media process without tearing. I recommend a good-quality stretched canvas or wood panel. I'll be using a **18" x 18" canvas**, but feel free to choose what feels right for you.

Acrylic Paints

You can use any paints you already love or explore a different color palette. Here are the ones I'll be using:

- Titanium White
- Black or Payne's Grey
- Yellow Ochre
- Burnt Umber
- Primary Red
- Hunter's Green
- Primary Yellow
- White Gesso

Acrylic Inks (Optional)

You can use any colors you already have or explore a different color palette. Here are the ones I'll be using:

- Hunter's Green
- Muted Green
- Olive Green
- Yellow Orange Azo

Alcohol Inks (Optional)

You can use any colors you already have or explore a different color palette. Here are the ones I'll be using:

- Rain Forest Green
- Orange
- Bright Yellow
- Magenta

Mediums (I'm Using)

- **Heavy Gel Medium** (Semi-gloss or Matte)
- Gel Medium (Semi-gloss or Matte) or Mod Podge
- (Optional) Hard Molding Paste: This can be mixed with paint or used alone to create texture. It dries very hard and durable but does require extra drying time.

Tools

- A **palette knife** or an old plastic card for scraping and layering.
- A variety of **small and large brushes:** Include detail brushes and a larger one for background work. Choose ones you're comfortable using and suitable for acrylics.
- Mark making tools: wire brush, etching tool, fork, putty knife.
- Your favorite journaling tools: I love using Stabilo All Pencils, Neocolor II crayons and Stablilo Woodys and Posca Paint Pens (black & white).
- An apron or clothes you don't mind getting messy.
- A palette for mixing paints.
- A spray bottle for water
- Painter's Tape for masking

Mixed Media Materials

This is where the magic happens! Here are some ideas to spark your imagination:

- **Papers** & **Ephemera**: Collage Papers, Vintage wallpaper, old books, sewing patterns, postcards, journal pages.
- Fabrics: Lace, ribbons, burlap, scraps of fabric from sentimental clothing.
- Found Objects: Jewellery, buttons, keys, or anything meaningful to you.

• **Texture Makers**: drywall tape, cardboard, lace, plaster, embroidery, or packing materials (like bubble wrap).

Think of these materials as treasures—each one bringing its own history, texture, and story to your work.
