Sovereign

Warrior

Use the following journal prompts and practices to embody your light archetypes and alchemize shadow into sovereignty.

Integration Practices

- Embodiment ritual: Move like each archetype. Notice how your body shifts between fear and power.
- *Mirror work:* Speak as your Sovereign. Name your desires out loud, every day.
- Flame Ritual: Light a candle as a symbol of your flame. Journal beside it each night for one week.
- Empowerment Ritual: Choose a shadow statement and rewrite it in your Magician's voice. Create a mantra from it.
- Sovereign Space Ritual: Build an altar for your Sovereign self. Include symbols of courage, vision, and truth.

Journal Prompts

- Where have I been leading from shadow instead of sovereignty?
- Which archetype feels most uncomfortable
 —and why?
- What does my Sovereign want to claim that my Child still fears?
- What boundaries must I reinforce to protect my vision?
- Where am I outsourcing my power, and how do I call it back?
- What truth am I no longer willing to silence?
- Which archetype within me is ready to lead next—and how will I honor it?
