STEP ONE:

The words capitalized above (MIGHTY, SAVES, REJOICE, DELIGHT, QUIET) are listed on the below (bolded and capitalized). To the right of each of those words are lists of synonyms and antonyms (similar and opposite words). Circle the similar/opposite words that impact you the most.

MIGHTY

Synonyms: strong, powerful, more than capable Antonyms: powerless, weak, insignificant, feeble

SAVES

Synonyms: frees, redeems, rescues, protects, takes care of, guards Antonyms: make vulnerable, desert, leave, endanger, harm

REJOICE

Synonyms: celebrate, delight, exult, revel Antonyms: grieve, sulk, lament, mourn

QUIET

Synonyms: soothe, calm, peaceful, rest, content, satisfied Antonyms: busy, upset, perturbed, agitated, troubled

DELIGHT

Synonyms: enjoyment, great pleasure or joy, happiness Antonyms: disappointed, displeased, disgusted, bothered

STEP TWO:

Ask Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth, to guide you as you amplify your passage with the words you chose that are meaningful to you. But also, be free to write other words or phrases that come to your mind because they too can be from Holy Spirit. Dallas Willard said, "God's gracious incursions into our souls can make our thoughts his thoughts. He will help us learn to distinguish when a thought is ours alone and when it is also his."

Don't be quick to evaluate. Just write and trust. When you are finished you can "weigh and test" them in your heart [1 Corinthians 14:29; 1 Thessalonians 5:19-21] and/or ask your pastor or spiritual leader you trust.
