Phase	School & Staff Actions	Leadership Actions	JSE Support	Outputs / Outcomes
Pre-Program – Baseline & Goal Setting	Provide existing student achievement data (phonics checks, spelling inventories, writing samples, or agreed measures).	Collate baseline data and share with JSE. Identify priority year levels or focus areas.	Data analysis session with JSE. Review baseline achievement. Set school-wide goals for growth.	Shared baseline picture of student achievement. Clear strategic priorities for the year.
Term 1 – Strategic Start & Alignment	Engage in curated modules. Use reflection templates in team meetings. Implement or continue structured literacy practices.	Introduce chosen learning pathway to staff. Set expectations for consistent implementation.	Coaching call to finalise goals and launch program. Bespoke Simplero platform set up with curated PL modules.	Shared literacy priorities. Staff equipped with curated learning hub. Action plans in place.
Term 2 – Professional Learning in Action	Apply agreed routines/strategies in classrooms. Share reflections. Evaluate impact through data analysis.	Oversee data collection and lead reflection sessions.	Coaching session focused on student data analysis. Adjust practices where needed.	Evidence of student progress. Data-informed refinements to practice.
Term 3 – Evidence & Evaluation	Build on Semester 1 successes. Continue to evaluate impact, coach teams, and grow knowledge through curated content.	Facilitate staff discussions using templates. Monitor practice across classrooms.	Coaching session to support implementation and troubleshoot barriers.	Staff aligned on routines. Early classroom evidence of consistent practice.
Term 4 – Consolidation & Next Steps	Revisit modules for consolidation. Document successes and challenges.	Lead whole-staff reflection on progress. Identify priorities for next year.	Final coaching session: review impact, consolidate gains, and map growth. Plan next steps.	Whole-school review. Next steps documented.
