



ETHICS IN PHOTONIC MEDICINE

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In order to be well informed when practising photonic medicine or photonic therapy it is better to be aware of way Law says in your country, and to respect what it says.

It is therefore your responsibility to inquire about the rules and regulations of your country.

The photonic therapy practitioner, as a healthcare professional, is first and foremost bound to respect the Hippocratic Oath and the applicable Code of Ethics of their professional College.

In many countries, only physicians (and sometimes midwives) are authorized to make a medical diagnosis and prescribe treatment.

Healthcare professionals or "paramedics" are responsible for administering the prescribed treatment.

And very often "healthcare practitioners," despite the importance of the services they provide, have no official recognition and are at best relegated to the "wellness" sector..

We had with Pr Magnin to register it in order to avoid confusion with practitioners who intended naming their practice “photonic medicine” without the minimum requirements we ask for.

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And mostly to protect us against complications or side effects that other practitioners using color in their therapeutic work may have without respecting the work processes which ensure safe practice for the patient.

Photonic medicine is a method with serious scientific foundations and well defined procedures which ensure its efficiency and safety.

It is not allowed to teach Photonic Medicine as to teach requires more than a regular practise, until one has developed a deep understanding and integration of the concepts and knowledge implied in medicine, physiology, biochemistry, biology, thermodynamics and physics, a process which requires time.

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Some practical advises for the healthcare practitioners

If necessary, have the patient wear a light white cotton undershirt during photon exposure to protect the intimacy of some patients, as photons do pass through.

The photonic therapy practitioner never intervenes in any acute or serious medical problem without medical supervision; they must absolutely ensure that the client is receiving proper medical care.

The photonic therapy practitioner respects the clients of their colleagues and does not attempt to solicit them.

The photonic therapy practitioner does not practice in public places and must under no circumstances demonstrate his art in public.

Committed to ensuring the safety of their patients and providing them with the best possible outcome, the photonic therapy practitioner undertakes to practice in accordance with the following fundamental principles:

1. They do not make diagnoses or dispute diagnoses made by a physician. They never discontinue ongoing medical treatment without the consent of the prescribing physician or specialist, and they do not oppose surgical intervention.
2. They never suggest that their patient interrupt medical follow-up, examinations, or investigations necessary to determine or clarify the cause(s) of their illness.

3. If he deems it necessary in the interest of—and to ensure the safety of—his patient, he will refer them to a physician better equipped to treat their case with the necessary expertise.

4. He will only disclose the results of his intervention with the consent of his patients.

5. He is bound by professional secrecy and the utmost discretion in all circumstances.

6. He makes it his duty to soothe, relieve, or alleviate, to the fullest extent of his abilities and skills, the suffering of those who seek his help.

7. He will provide his assistance and expertise, free of charge if necessary, to the indigent, the disabled, and the terminally ill, only at the request or on the advice of their attending physician.

8. He will not consult with or treat minor childrens or the mentally disabled without the presence of their parent(s) or legal guardian.

9. In his dealings with his patient, he shall remain sober, honest, and in good faith. He shall avoid false allegations, clumsy, and harmful words in his speech.

He shall not lull the patient with deceptive illusions.

10. In the exercise of his profession, the photonic therapy practitioner will not overestimate his skills or capabilities. This attitude will guarantee the safety of his actions for his patient, which will remain strictly complementary to medical treatment.

11. He must comply with the administrative requirements of the state(s) and country in which he practices and adhere to all applicable standards and regulations.

12. He refuses to equate the profession of photonic therapy practitioner with any occult or esoteric science, to confuse his art with so-called energy healing techniques lacking recognized scientific basis, or with divination or parapsychology.

13. “*Primum non nocere*” (first do no harm) is the motto of the photonic therapy practitioner, who at all times and in all places will respect the Hippocratic Oath.
