BIOGRAPHIC DATA:

- **Operational Legend:** Retired Professor of Applied Mathematics, St. Petersburg State University.
- **Physical Description:** 5'9", white, disordered hair. Wears thick-framed reading glasses covering eyes that are unnaturally alert for a civilian academic. Permanent ink stains on his right fingers.
- **Background:** One of the most brilliant computational minds of his generation. Formerly attached to the FSB's Technical Directorate, where he spent six years designing the foundational algorithms for the ██████████ weapon system. Formally retired three years ago.

PSYCHOLOGICAL PROFILE: Petrov is a man who built an absolute mathematical masterpiece, only to realize too late the horrific implications of its real-world deployment.
