**BIOGRAPHIC DATA:**

- **Education:** Exeter Academy; Yale University (Summa Cum Laude, International Relations; Skull and Bones). Master's degree from the Fletcher School at Tufts.
- **Languages:** Fluent Russian, Mandarin, German, and near-native French. Spoken with zero inflection, zero tell, and zero warmth.
- **Background:** Twenty-two year Agency veteran. Immaculate, almost suspiciously clean operational record across field postings in Berlin, Beijing, and Ankara. Appointed Moscow Station Chief six years ago.
