### 2. Message from the Board (Voorwoord)

The Stichting Positive Global Change Foundation was established with the profound belief that our world—every human, animal, and the natural environment—is unique and must be preserved for future generations. Since our incorporation on July 3, 2024, we have focused on building a foundation for impactful projects that address social participation, animal welfare, and environmental protection. We are proud of the progress made in our initial reporting period, including securing significant donations to launch our core initiatives.

### 3. About the Foundation (Objective & Strategy)

- **Mission and Vision:** We are dedicated to **improving life on our planet** through impactful projects, believing today's reality is shaped by past actions and committing to a brighter future.
- **Statutory Objective (Doelstelling):** The Foundation aims to support and initiate projects that enable people of all ages to lead healthy lives and access education, while advocating for animal welfare and the preservation of natural habitats.
- **Strategy and Multi-Year Plan:** Our strategy involves promoting youth and elderly care, international understanding, art, culture, nature conservation, and sport.
- **Main Activities:** Concrete actions include supporting **animal sanctuaries**, helping people in need and implementing the **"Spiel, Spaß und Bewegung" (Spel, plezier en beweging)** sports program in the Netherlands.

### 4. Governance & Organization

**Remuneration Policy (Beloningsbeleid):** Board members are not remunerated for their roles but are entitled to a **non-excessive attendance fee** and an **expense allowance**.

**Personnel & Volunteers:** The Foundation relies on the support of its board and the broader community under the motto **#ITSTARTSWITHME**.

## 5. Report on Activities & Impact (Operational Review)

- **Animal Welfare:** We support the **Món La Bassa** sanctuary in Spain, providing a second chance for rescued animals.
- **Help Valencia flood victims rebuild their lives:** Devastating floods in October 2024 have left families in Valencia without homes, food, and basic necessities. Positive Global Change is providing direct local support, ensuring aid reaches those who need it most—fast and efficiently.
- **Casa Mae:** a housing project in Portugal supporting abused girls (one-time donation)
- **Trees for All:** another Dutch Stichting supporting sustainable forestry projects all over the world. Besides helping to make the Netherlands greener, we're also active in the rest of Europe and in developing countries. (one-time donation)
  
- **Fundraising:** Income is generated through contributions from entities using the Positive Global Change trademark, as well as subsidies, donations, and legacies.

## 6. Financial Review

- **Financial Performance:** For the initial period, the Foundation achieved a total available income of **€107,340**.
- **Income Breakdown:** This includes **€107,225** in donations and **€115** in other operating income (cashback).
- **Expenditure Breakdown:**
  - **€67,337** was donated to charitable causes.
  - Operating costs totaled **€24,490**, primarily driven by **automation and marketing costs** (€18,234).
- **Reserves and Funds Policy:** The net result of **€15,513** has been allocated to the **Other reserves**.

## 7. Outlook for 2026

In the coming year, the Foundation will focus on the full-scale launch of our sports initiatives in the Netherlands. We will continue to seek additional contributors to expand our global impact.
