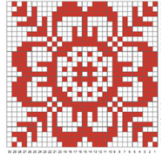


Norwegian Leaves



NORWEGIAN
KNITTING

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FREE PATTERN:
Shawl: Norwegian Leaves



This decorative triangular Shawl will keep you nice and warm!

Gauge: 20 stitches x 39 rows garter knitting on 10 x 10 cm.

Needle size: 4,5 mm /US 7, adjust according to gauge.

Yarn suggestion: Sport or DK/Light Worsted, 5-8 ply, adjust according to gauge/needles.

This pattern works well with "leftover yarn", too.

PATTERN:

Knit back and forth (garter stitch) on circular needles.

Cast on 168 stitches on circular needles size 4,5 mm (US size 7), with your choice of a contrast color. Knit 2 rows (garter stitch).

Next round (1): Change color (to the main/basic color of your choice), knit 2 stitches together (loosely), knit until you have 1 stitch left, take yarn over needle (to create a new stitch), and knit the remaining stitch.

2. Knit garter stitches

3. Knit the first 2 stitches together (loosely), then also the next 2 stitches together (loosely), knit the rest of the stitches (garter). You now have 166 stitches.

4. Knit garter stitch

Repeat rows no. 1 – 4, 3 more times, and you will have 160 stitches.

We are now at row no. 17.

r. 17: Switch to a contrast color of your choice.

Knit the 2 first stitches together (loosely), then knit the next 2 stitches together (loosely), knit until you have 1 stitch left, and increase 1 stitch (make a double stitch in the remaining stitch).

r.18: Turn and knit 3 stitches.

Turn again, and knit 2 stitches, and increase 2 stitches in the last stitch.

Turn and knit 5 stitches.

Turn again, and knit 4 stitches, then increase 2 stitches in the last stitch on the needle.

Turn and knit 7 stitches.

Turn again, and knit 6 stitches, then increase by knitting 2 stitches in the last stitch.

Turn and knit 9 stitches.

Turn again, and knit 8 stitches, increase by knitting 2 stitches in the last stitch on the needle. (This will be the "midpoint" of the "leaf")

Turn, cast off the first stitch, knit 7 stitches.

Turn, knit 8 stitches.

Turn, cast off the first stitch, knit 5 stitches.

Turn, knit 6 stitches.

Turn, cast off the first stitch, knit 3 stitches.

Turn, knit 4 stitches.

Needle sizes:

U S size 0	2.0 mm
U S size 1	2.25 mm
U S size 2	2.75 mm
U S size 3	3.25 mm
U S size 4	3.5 mm
U S size 5	3.75 mm
U S size 6	4.0 mm
U S size 7	4.5 mm
U S size 8	5.0 mm
U S size 9	5.5 mm
U S size 10	6.0 mm
U S size 10.5	6.5 mm
U S size 11	8.0 mm
U S size 13	9.0 mm
U S size 15	10.0 mm

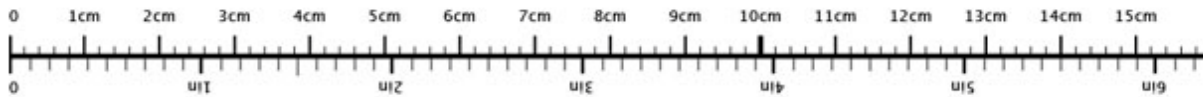
Turn, cast off the first stitch, knit 1 stitch.

Turn, knit 2 stitches.

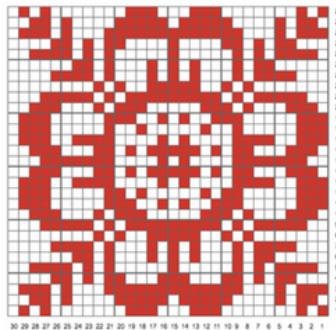
Turn, cast off the first stitch, knit ALL of the remaining stitches on the needle. = 158 stitches on needle.

Keep repeating rows 1 – 18, including switching between main and contrasting color(s), until you have 8 stitches left. Then: Knit 2 stitches together, knit 4, 2 together. (=6 stitches)

Cast off.



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
