Scandinavian Knitting Design: HAT in Sandnes Peer Gynt yarn

(Sandnes Pattern no. 15-37)



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SANDNESGARN

Sizes:

(One size).

Yarn Requirements:

Peer Gynt

Colour 1088: 50 g.

Colour 1002: 100 g.

Alternatives:

Alpakka, Smart, Duo, Mandarin Classic.

Knitting needles:

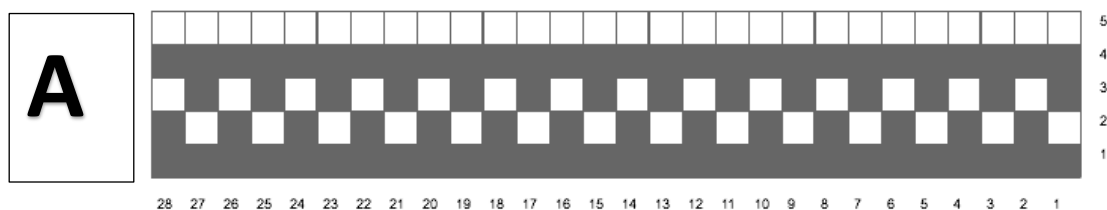
Small circular needle 2½ and 3½ mm.

Tension/Gauge:

22 sts stockinette stitch on needles 3½ = 10 cm

Cast on and join 116 stitches in main colour (1002) on small circular needle 2½ mm. Work 4 cm stocking stitch, and purl 1 row (for a folding edge).

Change to needles 3½ mm. Work pattern according to diagram/chart **A** :



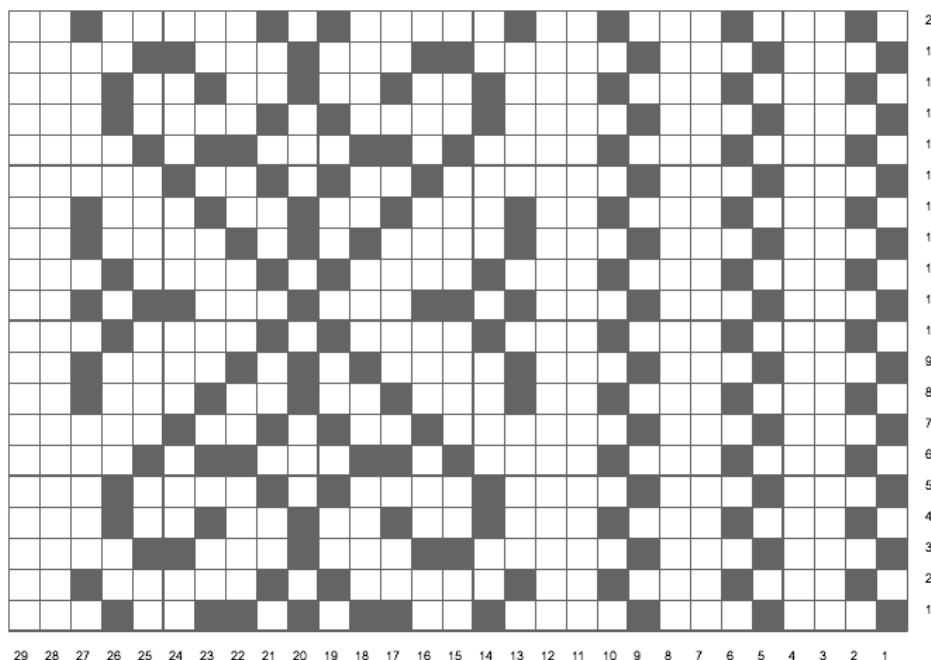
← Start here, continue/work all around the rounds/rows (the hat) – we knit from left to right.

Repeat all the way around the hat.



Continue to work pattern according to diagram/chart **B**, which is repeated until the hat measures approx 18 cm from the folding edge:

↑ Repeat pattern until hat measures approx 18cm from folding edge.

← Start here, and repeat the pattern all the way around (4 times)

When the hat is approx.18cm, knit 2 stitches together in every vertical stripe in the main colour (1002), and you will have decreased by 16 stitches by the end of this row, and have 100 stitches left.

Work 3 rows, and remember: you now have only 1 stitch in the main colour (1002) in each of the vertical stripes.

Change to contrast colour (1002), and do: *knit 2, knit 2 together*.

Repeat this (from *-*, which means knit 2, knit 2 together) to the end of the row.

Work 2 rows without decreasing.

Then work like this: *knit 1, knit 2 together*, repeat from *-* to the end of row.

Work 2 rows without decreasing.

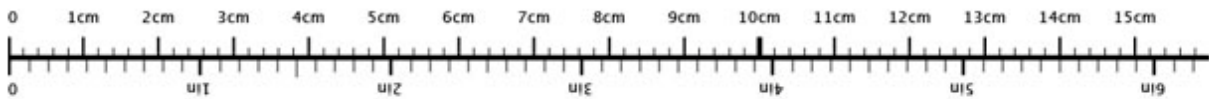
Cut thread, pull it through the stitches and fasten well. Fold the hem against the inside, and sew up, using loose stitches. Make a large pom-pom in contrast colour (1088) and sew it on to the top.

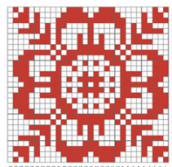
