

## CHILD'S PERSONAL TIME LINE

**Materials:** Sheets of graph paper, pasted together, to make a time line. Also the child's photographs.

**Presentation:** Measure length of graph paper and divide into sections, perhaps 12 inches to stand for one year. Write at the top the numbers of the months (1 through 12) in blue numbers, each year in red numbers. At the beginning of the line, there should be a star for the child's birth.

Child takes collection of photographs provided by parents and places them along the time line in the correct chronological sequence. Then they are pasted onto the chart. The child who can write can write a little text underneath the pictures. The text is written according to the child's ability: single words, phrases or sentences.

**Purpose:** To help the child understand time in relation to his or her life.

**Age:** 5 years and up
