

## DAY TO DAY TIME LINE

**Materials:** A calendar in the class where the numbers of the day can be removed, pasted on a sheet of paper or a card (5x9).

**Presentation:**

This project is for older children and is best done in the afternoon. One or two children may work together. Pull off number of today's date and paste it at top of index card. Now children think of something special that happened on this day. The children decide on what event. Children draw a picture and write a text about it. Card is now attached to previous cards with tape and this can become an ongoing time line of the day to day events in the class.

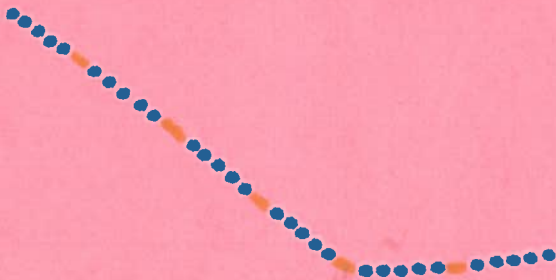
It can be stored easily by folding along tape, and for parent night can be placed along a long wall.

This might be called a Class Diary.

**Purpose:** To have a more precise understanding of the passage of time.

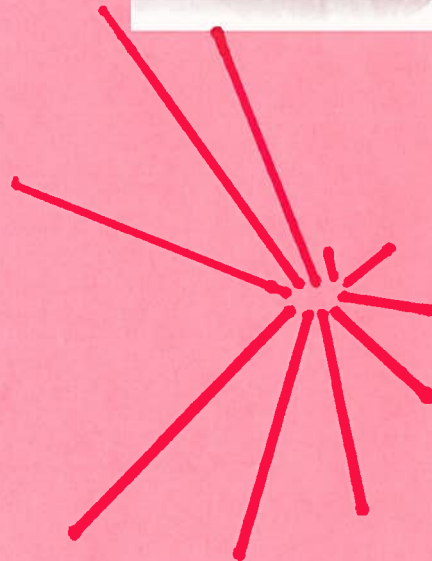
**Age:** 5 years and up
