How effective are your current professional learning arrangements?

Traditional professional learning in schools usually involves sending teachers and/or school leaders to an all day workshop. This arrangement may leave you wondering what the outcomes are that justify the expense and disruption to school life.

Professional Learning Services Available in 2021

Teach Alongs do not require the hiring of relief teachers, nor do they interrupt your school schedule.



Reading Success in the Early Primary Years



In this 12 week course teachers will learn to fully implement the Science of Reading to get every child in their class reading without worksheets, guessing strategies or tears.

By the end of this 12 week Teach Along teachers will have

- Developed a strong understanding of how to teach the
- 5 components of reading instruction according to the
- science.
- Planned and conducted lessons using the explicit teaching model
- · Developed an explicit and highly effective daily literacy block
- Conducted daily shared writing lessons in your class
- Planned and taught lessons with the aim of building strong oral language skills in students
- Used rich text to support oral language, sentence structure and writing development
- Assessed and taught phonological and phonemic awareness skills
- Planned and taught systematic, explicit phonics lessons according to the science of reading
- · Assessed and monitored students' phonics skills
- Used decodable texts to support children's reading skills
- Communicated with parents about the science of reading and how they can support their children at home
- Taught irregular, high frequency words in a way that supports children's reading and spelling development without guessing

Teachers enter either the Foundation (first year of school) or Year 1&2 Stream. The overall content is similar each week, but is targeted at the different needs of the students for their particular grade.

Writing Success in the Early Primary Years




Over 12 weeks teachers will explore the essential components of writing; transcription, spelling, expressive language, sentence structure, grammar and text composition are all explored.

By the end of this 12 week Teach Along teachers will have

- A sound understanding of the different levels of writing: sub-word, word, sentence and discourse.
- Developed a sound instructional routine for handwriting
- Implemented instructional routines for daily word and sentence level writing.
- Developed a plan for teaching morphology, sentence structure, vocabulary and language features using an explicit teaching model.
- A clear understanding of the role of picture books in oral language and writing development.
- Analysed a rich text to determine its suitability as the stimulus of learning.
- Set language and writing goals for their classes.
- Considered the need of EAL/D learners and developed appropriate goals
- Built the field for a text including front loading vocabulary, questioning and engaging students in drama activities.
- Developed a plan for building comprehension including making connections and labelling pictures.
- Worked with students to unpack the text and examine text structure.
- Explored characters with students using the explicit teaching model.
- Used a chosen text as the stimulus for teaching syntax, sentence structure and language features.
- Guided students through writing their own texts.
- Adjusted planning and lessons to suit the cognitive load needs of students.



Supporting Struggling Readers



Approximately ten percent of students will experience a reading difficulty. This six week Teach Along walks teachers and education assistants through responding to the needs of students experiencing reading difficulty.

By the end of this 6 module course teachers and education assistants will have

- · An understanding of the simple view of reading
- A clear comprehension of the possible causes of reading difficulty and how to identify students with a potential reading difficulty.
- Planned classroom teaching using the Response to Intervention Model
- Planned instruction to support students' cognitive load
- A sound knowledge of the role of phonological and phonemic awareness and the skills involved in each.
- Conducted assessment in phonological and phonemic awareness
- · Conducting phonological and phonemic awareness intervention
- Designed a data driven reading support program
- Conducted assessment in phonics
- Planned and conducted phonics intervention



Professional Coaching

I recommend 4 x 60 minute coaching sessions per person spaced roughly a month apart. The first session is spent getting to know you and forming clarity around long term goals. Many people find that they leave the first session thinking, "I thought my need was ____ but it's really ____." From there, we talk about what is working, what is getting in the way and, together, find a way forward. One on one coaching is suited to classroom teachers, senior teachers and curriculum coaches & coordinators who are looking to supercharge their work.



Give yourself and the members of your team the gift of time. Time to reflect, time to talk about what is important and time to grow.

Instructional Development Packages

In-school workshops are an opportunity to have your school's needs placed at the centre of professional learning provision. My workshops are focused on collaborative problem solving, evaluation of current practice and the formation of common sense action plans that are aimed at moving your school closer to your strategic goals.

The structure of the package is:

- 1 x 3 hour live online session with school leaders
- 2 x 1 hour sessions with the whole staff/team delivered live to help teachers and assistants to develop the fundamental knowledge base required to engage with the development of practice.



- 1×1 hour session with whole staff to workshop a shared vision and understanding of goals and next steps
- 1 x 2 hour live session with school leaders to examine staff feedback, address staff need for in-school training, support and coaching and develop a clear plan for the next steps in implementing the school's plan.
