

Installation Support for Don Neuhauser Nut String Lifter--Steve Eulberg

Hey there,

I normally do this in person at a festival, workshop or private lesson, but since we can't do that this year and we still want to play our resonator instrument, this will have to do!

The Raised Nut that is enclosed is designed to sit overtop of the nut (near the peghead) of your instrument.

It already has slots filed in it for your strings.

There are (5) Slots so that you could set your instrument up for 3 or 4 string playing.

We are aiming for the 4-Equidistant String configuration, so omit the middle slot and use both outside slots and the other two that result in the strings being equally distant from each other.



Process:

1. Loosen your strings
2. Place the Nut String Lifter over the Nut. (refer to the pages in your QT Dulci-Bro Workshop handout for photos)
3. Replace the strings and tune up!

FYI: I use Resonator / Reso-phonic Guitar Strings (gauges are heavier than typical dulcimer strings)

Gauges:

D = .036

F# = .028

A = .019

d = .016

If your instrument has lighter gauge strings and you'd like to replace with a heavier gauge string, this is the perfect time!~
