SUPPLIES

Basic

Scissors

Apron

Sewing machine and thread in cream/white and black

[Glue stick](#)

Fabric Paper

Muslin - about 13" x 22"

Book pages - about 10

Elmer's glue

Spray bottle with water

[Two cheap chip brushes](#) or other bristle brushes

White acrylic paint

[Freezer paper](#) - about 15" x 23"

Envelopes/Pages

Twelve - [9 x 12 catalog envelopes](#)

Assorted acrylic paints

Optional: [GelliArts Gel plate](#)* and [brayer](#)

Paint brushes - a couple will work

[Deli paper](#) or [freezer paper](#) for monoprinting

Covers

Muslin - 20" x 16"

Fabric strips - about 25 strips at about 1" x 17"

Gel medium or adhesive of choice

Trowel or scraper

[Mat board](#) -

(2) 9 1/2" x 6 1/2"

(1) 9 1/2" x 1"

[Duck cloth](#) -

(2) 9 1/2" x 6 1/2"

(1) 9 1/2" x 1"

Fabric (coordinate with the fabric strips stitched to cover fabric) -

(2) 9 1/4" x 6 1/4"

Collage Pieces for Book Cover

Small bits of lace, fabric scraps and duck cloth

Found words (see download for ideas)

A few straight pins

Tags

[Twelve shipping tags](#)

Small bits of lace, fabric scraps, twine and ribbon

[Adhesive magnets**](#) (2-3)

Pages

[Wax bookbinder thread](#)

[Bookbinder needle](#)

[Book awl/paper piercer](#)

Four (4) pieces of ribbon - 24" x 1/2" each

[Twine](#) - about 1 yard

[Small crochet hook](#) - about 1/2" (optional)

[Exacto blade](#) and [small cutting mat](#)

Pencil or [disappearing ink pen](#) (optional)

Cardstock or paper - 9 1/2" x 2"

Bonus Project

[Elastic](#) - 1/2" width cut to about 22" in length

Strip of fabric: about 2 strips - each at about 1 1/2" x 21"

Small bits of lace
