Fabric & Stuff • 1/2 yard of Muslin • 1/2 yard Duck Cloth/Canvas • Sewing Machine & Thread	Paper • Newsprint Paper {I use 24"x 19} • Scrap Paper: ledger, music, text, etc.	Adhesives • Matte Medium or PVA • Glue Stick	Writing Tools • Black Sharpie Pen or other permanent pen. • Sharpie Poster-Paint Pen in white or black.

Liquitex Quinacridone Crimson; Light Portrait Pink and Brilliant Yellow Green.

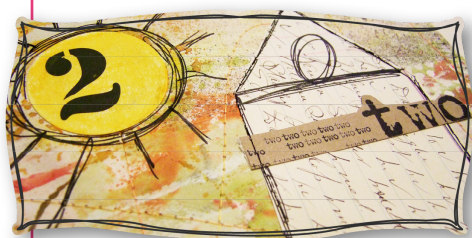

*For the inks that do not come in spray bottles, I added a few of them to small spray bottles that can be picked up at your local craft store.



Basics:

Inexpensive paint brushes, paper towels, ruler, pencil, scissors, heat gun, binder clips or large paper clips, small paint cups, water, water cup for brushes, gesso, letter size file folders {approximately 10}, stencils, cardstock, brayer, 2-3 small spray bottles, and Walnut Ink.
