 - A square piece of fabric around 3 x 3 and another about 2 3/4 x 2 3/4 but watch video for directions.

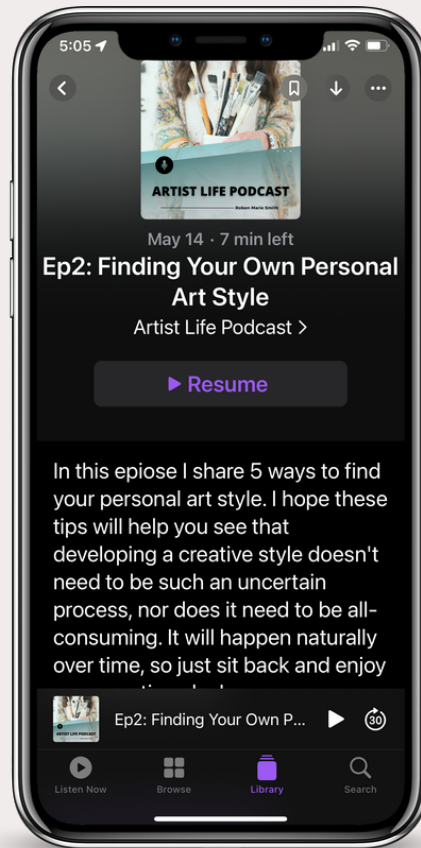
Source for my linen fabric pieces on [ETSY](#).
