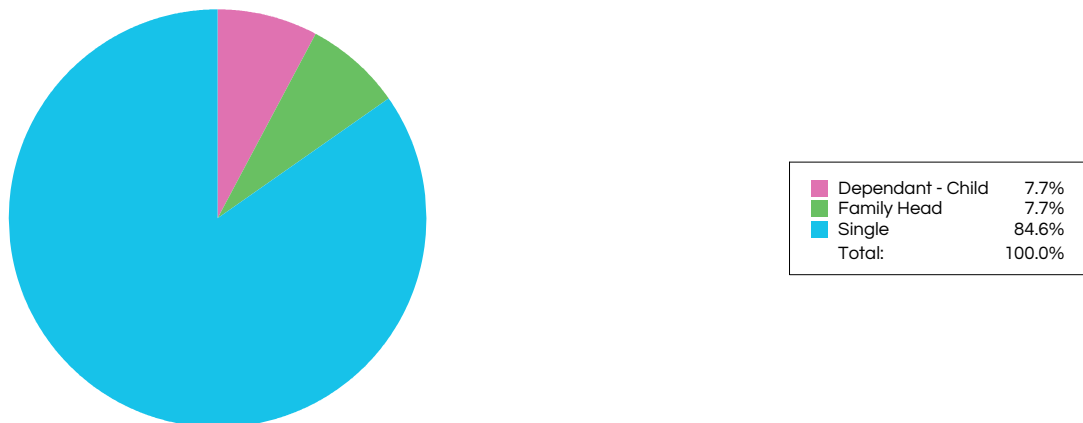

Household Stays

*Under the Ontario CHPI program, one of the mandatory reporting requirements is to indicate the number of households that stayed in an emergency shelter during a fiscal year. This indicator leads to some confusion among Service Managers, because it further goes on to explain that "A household that experiences multiple transitions in a reporting period may be counted multiple times under this indicator. **This indicator does not track unique households.**" So while the wording suggests that Service Managers are to count the number of households, they are actually required to report on the number of stays accumulated, per household - a measure we call **household stays**.*
