Welcome

English is a morpho-phonemic language, meaning that accurate spelling relies on a combination of phonics, orthography, morphology and etymology. *Spelling Success in Action* supports this learning through explicit, systematic instruction that guides teachers and students in exploring language at four levels: grapheme/morpheme, word, sentence and text. This progression helps students apply new learning in meaningful contexts, promoting deeper understanding and long-term retention.

The series is designed with built-in differentiation, making it easier for teachers to support the variation in reading and spelling development within a class. Its low floor, high ceiling design ensures lessons are accessible to all learners while still providing opportunities for challenge and extension.

Spelling Success in Action 1 is designed for older students who need to strengthen foundational spelling knowledge. Many upper-primary students still have gaps in phonics, orthographic patterns, suffixing conventions and basic morphology. To address these needs, the program provides two pathways:

- **Phonics Essentials**, which delivers explicit, systematic phonics instruction.
- **Morphology Essentials**, which introduces high-utility prefixes, suffixes and suffixing conventions.

Together, these pathways provide an efficient catch-up sequence that builds the foundations required for successful spelling development.

Spelling Success in Action 2 and *Spelling Success in Action 3* build on these foundations through a deeper study of morphology. Students explore prefixes and suffixes and Latin and Greek, developing a richer understanding of word meaning, structure and etymology. This knowledge supports spelling accuracy, vocabulary growth, reading comprehension and written expression.

Our specially written 'stepped' readers provide the opportunity to apply new knowledge of morphology to reading authentic texts while supporting each student with the support that they need. All readers contain:

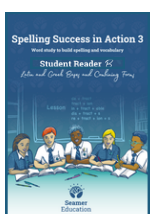
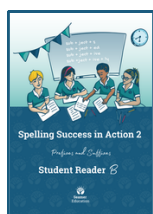
- The same key vocabulary featuring the new morpheme

This means that teachers can engage students in discussions centred on comprehension of the text and all students can be fully engaged. To protect the dignity of struggling students, all books have identical covers, with the only difference being a single identifying letter.



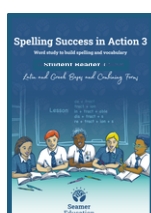
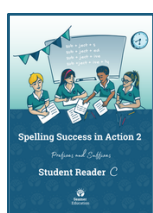
STUDENT READER A - 100 WORDS PER PASSAGE

Includes blending support, larger text and simplified sentences. While the core content of the texts is the same as other readers, surrounding vocabulary in these passages is simplified to ensure focus on key content. Words containing the key morphemes are underlined for easier identification during following-up tasks.



STUDENT READER B - 150 WORDS PER PASSAGE

Designed for the 'average' student, these passages have approximately 150 words to enable students to use their new learning to comprehend text. Wide line spacing in the passage means that partners can read together, pointing for each other as they read for a fully-interactive experience.



STUDENT READER C - 200 WORDS PER PASSAGE

With an increased word count, smaller text, more complex vocabulary and more complex sentence structure, Reader C is designed to engage higher-flying students who enjoy reading richer texts.

IMPLEMENTATION COACHING

Spelling knowledge includes phonics, orthography and morphology. Morphology instruction can be run whole class with adjustment to support students as needed. However, phonics and orthography instruction need to be run according to what your data is telling you. Not only will your implementation coaching include support to get ready for morphology instruction, but you will be supported to collect data about phonics knowledge and plan for effective instruction that ensures that all students have access to the learning they need.

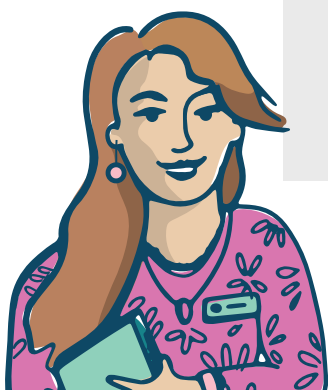

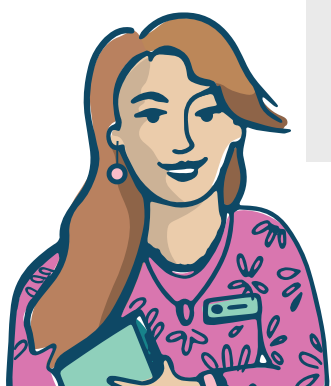

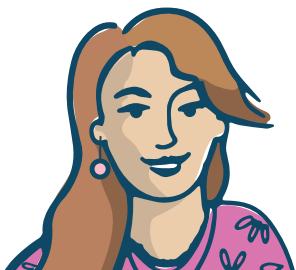
